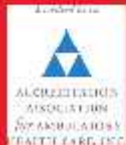

The Aspen Grove Center for Pain Management at 7575 Secur Road in Lambertville, MI will start scheduling patients on August 1 and be the primary location for Dr. Otting's practice. He will also utilize CCPM's ambulatory surgical facility, the West Central Surgical Center at the main practice location on Central Avenue in Toledo.

CCPM has scheduled an Open House at the Lambertville location on Wednesday, August 31 from 5:30-7:30 p.m. All area caregivers and Bedford Township officials and businesses are welcome to attend.
